LIVE EVENT – ROUTE DIRECTOR



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THINK IT MIGHT BE THE PLACE FOR YOU? THIS IS THE JOB ON OFFER.

Join the crew as the route manager. You will be expected to take responsibility of a small team, signing the route before the live event day, and managing the route and any issues on the live event. You will be responsible for the route briefings to all participants and will report any issues to event control throughout the event.

Responsibilities include:

- Performing a route recce and identify potential pit stop locations (pre-event)
- Performing a risk assessment (pre-event)
- Producing a signage plan (pre-event)
- Conducting a dynamic risk assessment and health and safety checks along the route (live event)
- Managing cut off times along the route
- Managing route crew including signage teams and backmarkers
- Maintaining close contact with event control
- Participating in the event debrief (post-event)

The teams you'll manage will help support you with the following:

Signage –

- o This role will be helping to set-up and sign the route before the live event. This will also mean you are ensuring the route is safe and ready for the event to begin.
- You may also be expected to manage a section of the route on the event days themselves.
- You might also be part of the signage-down team, where you will have to remove the signs from the route after all participants have passed, making sure the route is left as it was before the event started!

Backmarkers –

- This role will involve following the route behind the final participants on the course.
 This means words of encouragement, positive energy and empathy will be vital for delivering this role effectively.
- This may also mean that you will have to communicate with the broom vehicles if participants are falling behind the cut-off times at Pit Stops.

Glow-stickers –

 Help to place glowsticks, and signs, on the route so that when it gets dark, participants can follow the route without getting lost.
