

## Route Crew Job Description

**Work with the route manager to set up the route signage the day before and manage the route on event day**

- A level of fitness to be able to walk 20-40km a day and be confident to work independently at times is required.
- You will also need to be able to use navigation apps on your phone. The Route Director will provide you with all the details of the apps, how to use them, and map files.
- You may also need to drive your own vehicle or have access to a bike to use on the event.
- The Route Manager will be in touch to give you all the details of your role 2 weeks ahead of the event.
- You will be expected to help to set up and sign the route the day before the event.
- You will need to work with the Route Manager to manage a section of the route on the live event day. The role may include checking the signage, back marking the route, taking the signage down or re-routing sections throughout the event if necessary.
- Make sure the route is left as it was before the event started with all signs removed.
- You will report to the Route Manager and work closely with the rest of the route team.
