

Driver Job Description

Being reactive and responsive to the needs of the event, as assigned by event control. You must be 25 years of age and hold a UK drivers licence

Route Vehicles

There are three route vehicles on this event and your primary role is to support with transporting participants who drop out on the route and at pit stops to the finish or a later section on the route. We will be encouraging participants to at least make it to the next pit stop where possible.

Aside from your main role as a driver please help at each pit stop as you go through and be on hand to move any logistics equipment between sites if necessary.

You will all be given a tracker and you must make sure this is on your person at all times so Event Control can see where your vehicle is. Event control will have your number and will call you to coordinate any pick-ups and let you know where you are needed.

Plan for the day

Vehicles 1&3 will be required to pick up lunches from the start site and deliver these to the crews at the respective Pit Stops.

- Route vehicle 1 will start at the AM pit stop and help out until the site is set up or required elsewhere
- Route vehicle 2 will start at the Lunch and help out until this site is set up or required elsewhere
- Route vehicle 3 will start at the PM pit stop and help out until this site is set up or required elsewhere

Water Van

The fourth driver in the small van will start the day at the start site. Once the event has started, they will take filled jerry cans and skittles to locations on the route between pit stops with another general crew member. There are 2 water stops for the full marathon and one for the half marathon depending on the weather.
