We're the project managers responsible for the physical and technical delivery of every element of our events and we oversee the live event experience of some 40,000 participants per annum. You'll be in the early stages of your events career, ambitious, with a keen interest in outdoor event operations and the desire to learn as much as you can from a world-class team.

- Support the Event Director with the project management and delivery of outdoor challenge events
- Plan event logistics such as people, venues and vehicles
- Coordinate the live event delivery of key logistical elements of the events and related teams

- Source, negotiate with, agree budgets and, contract suppliers


